- **Tourism Numbers Indicate Steady Recovery** | *The Minister of Tourism, David Collado announced that the tourism sector is in a clear recovery process, especially in the country's eastern region. Collado indicated that during the first 25 days of October Punta Cana received 21,486 international tourists, showing an increase of 92 percent compared to the same period in September. www.asonahores.com*
