What's New in Dominican Republic:

- **Dominican Republic to Implement New Electronic Ticket Portal for Inbound and Outbound Travel |** *In an effort to help reduce the spread of COVID-19, starting November 29, 2020, the Dominican Republic will adopt a new electronic system providing digital versions of all required travel forms. All passengers entering and departing the country will be required to fill out and submit their digital forms through the Electronic Ticket Portal either before or upon their arrival to the country. This new system is the result of extensive work and collaboration between the Dominican Republic Ministry of Tourism, Public Health, and the Department of Customs and Immigration. www.eticket.migracion.gob.do*
- **U.S. Lowers Travel Advisory for the Dominican Republic |** *As of November 19, the U.S. Department of State has dropped the level 4 'do not travel' advisory for the Dominican Republic to a level 3 'reconsider travel', stating that travelers should 'reconsider travel' to the Dominican Republic due to 'health and safety measures and COVID-related conditions'. This update, which comes in advance of key travel season, further underscores the Dominican Republic's dedicated efforts on a responsible tourism recovery approach that prioritizes the health and safety of international tourists. www.travelpulse.com*
