What's New in Dominican Republic:

- **Dominican Republic Projects Promising Arrival Numbers** | *The Association of Hotels and Tourism of the Dominican Republic, expects the month of March to exceed 220,000 tourist arrivals, which represents a growth of 35 percent compared to February 2021. Experts also anticipate another 100,000 passenger arrivals for easter break. Tourism activity in Dominican Republic continues to recover and is expected to face significant growth as vaccination advances in the country. www.mitur.gob.do*
- **Ministry of Tourism Presents New Digital Platform** | *As an integral part of the government's transparency strategy, the President of the Dominican Republic, Luis Abinader, accompanied by the Minister of Tourism, David Collado, led the launch of a new Tourist Intelligent System (SITUR), which combines information generated by several other new digital platforms. - **Frontier Announced New Flight Routes to Punta Cana** | *On March 8, Frontier Airlines formally inaugurated its new route from Miami to Punta Cana.
